Maximum number of pages: 12

Text processor: MS Word

Paper size: A4

Page margins: top 3 cm; bottom 6,7 cm;

right 4,2 cm; left 4,2 cm

Header: 2 cm; footer 5,5 cm

Font – Times New Roman 12 points.,

Reference– 9 points.,

Headlines and Headings should be bold with respectively bigger font than main text

Text should be justified (aligned to both left and right)

Single spacing

Line spacing – 1,5 line

Indentation of the first line of a paragraph - 1 cm

Language: Polish/English

Wide of charts and figures should not be more than 12,6 cm (not exceed margins) - grey colour not recommended.

Font for charts and figures– 7-10 pkt.
